After you have a scheduled date for cardiac surgery, you may need to be admitted to the cardiothoracic surgical ward located on 4th FL, Sorkor Building for patient preparation.

Step-by-Step to admission process:

- i. Once you get the confirmed bed available, you should prepare the required documents as follows:
- 1. National ID card (Both original and copy needed)
- 2. Health Insurance Card/ National Health Care Card (Both original and copy needed)
- 3.MD Referral Document (Case of Civil Servant without automatic reimbursed billing)
- 4. King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital ID Card
- ii. Bring all documentation in #1 along with your medical record with you or your family to the hospital
- iii. Go to Sor-Kor Building (map # 49)
- iv. Take the elevator to FL 4
- v. Once you get out of the elevator, the cardiac surgery ward is located on your right hand side. Please direct to the nurse station
